## Police SNT report

Stefan Henriksen said that latter part of last year Cedars Park had no proper policing team but now we are at full strength. Crime statistics slightly better than previous year. As from 19<sup>th</sup> April police hubs have been put in place across Suffolk this has increased efficiency and communication.

## Questions from Floor

Rubbish etc. Left around balancing pond

One phone call received from the public about a group camping and leaving a mess was dealt with successfully by P.C Henrikson. Any complaints ring the Martlesham number.

The chairman advised the floor that at this moment in time there is no official body responsible for clearing rubbish in that area. Providing they are not causing a nuisance no problem.

## Where can youths gather together?

There is a youth organisation who have a van full of sports equipment who will be on recreation grounds for next six or seven weeks at Chilton Youth worker only available for short time another two hoping to be employed.

## Drinking ban

Council have looked into this and decided a ban is not required Cllr Whittle who has been pushing for this said Mr John Spitzer Community safety officer was adamant about this.

## Speeding

Speed checks were carried out last year but none this year reason equipment needed has to be borrowed from elsewhere. Police hope to get own equipment in near future speed guns etc.

## Parking on pavements

Stefan said if you can get a buggy or wheelchair past it would be O.K. if you are forced into the road first try a friendly word with the perpetrator if you get no joy get in touch with police. Rogers comments on this were that roads were not wide enough on some parts and lot of roads not yet adopted'

## Chairman's report

There were small improvements during 2009 However over last twelve months the situation has stagnated and no progress on 106 agreements and other issues. C.P.R.S. has withdrawn from the Stakeholders meetings because the administration was poor no minutes taken communication nil.

When it first started it was fine it then started going backwards. Dealing with our local authorities

Is like mating Elephants lot of grunting and groaning and two years to produce any thing. Examples

Of this toucan crossing just over two years hard standings for busses nearly four years Parking at Tescos double yellow lining lorries now park on road between yellow lines this is frustrating us as

Police can not do anything.

Busses are to be looked at once bridge is open

The container depot is still ongoing the Council have put forward new ideas part of the Stowmarket action plan details are available on MSDC web site. Site will be developed some time distribution and offices, problem could be number of lorries joining Tesco roundabout possibly about one a minute we were told this was not a problem so we did a traffic survey for one hour and counted 2080 movement in lorries vans and cars.

Community centre Crest Nicholson have purchased the land and will build a purpose built facility

Plans were rejected but the principles were adopted. Negotiations opened in January but officers at Mid Suffolk deemed it inappropriate for us to attend these meetings. No update on these meetings.

Crest have put forward to complete the sight money from sale of houses from Crest £500,000 ring fenced for community centre which Crest will build.

When the centre is finished the idea was to form a Community Interest company non profit making and it would be run by you the Cedars Park Residents. If we get this the hall would be bigger than this one we propose a bar stage kitchen etc. Possible space for tennis bowls football pitch So many functions could be held in and outside the centre. The Recreation area is an utter disgrace it needs relaying its like the Andes it still has not been adopted bearing in mind amount of council tax we pay Fred painstakingly carried out a survey on amount of council tax we pay at Cedars Park at this moment it stands at £1,856,166-40. Still lot of roads not adopted this needs to be sorted.

I am entirely on your side and am appalled at E Mails not being answered and will personally look into this. Apologised for what has happened Page and a half of notes what he will look into. Most of council tax goes to County Looking at alcohol ban we are part of Stowmarket so let's get bureaucracy out of the way and get this sorted. Speeding signs apply to get an application form Local strategic partnership plenty of money Tim is chairman of this he will do battle with county council to sort this. He has said this in public and he will stand by it. Adoption of roads he will take this up with Highways also. Stakeholders forum furious about secrecy will look into this as well. Health centre bus shelters Tim has taken all of this on board. Lorry Park needed somewhere on A14 near Haughly Tim apologised for what has not happened at cedars Park assured us he will now be pushing all these problems. Peter Woodley is pursuing this as well. Plans should soon be in for rest of site this includes Community Centre. Are we part of Stowmarket was mentioned various comments were made on this issue Roger stated yes we are part of Stowmarket. If the relief road was not required Cedars Park wouldn't have been built. When our Community Centre is up and running it will be available for all people in the area for any use same as any other Centre.
